

World History Thesis Paper

You will be writing a 4-5-page paper for the semester project. The subject of the paper will be chosen by the student and is limited to an EVENT(s) that has occurred throughout history of the world but **cannot** be primarily about the United States. Your paper must have a thesis statement. This is a statement by you and in your researched opinion, which states what the point of the paper will be about. The following is an example of a thesis statement. World wars, violence, and terrorism would be at a much lower level if a woman were President of the United States. Another example: The United States should not have dropped the second atomic bomb on Japan during WWII. (*Please note that the above examples cannot be used because they are about the United States, however they are examples of what I want for your thesis*). You cannot have the same topic as another student. Please sign up when you have your topic or thesis statement.

The paper should have the following specifications:

1. Introduction with Thesis Statement
2. Supporting evidence (Proof of your thesis)
3. Conclusion
4. 5 sources - At least two must be books.
5. Typed and double spaced
 - a. 1" margins
 - b. 12 pt. Font
 - c. Black ink
6. 4-5 pages
7. No cover sheet is needed.
8. Title
9. Bibliography

The following due dates will keep you on track.

Outline of the paper is due: Oct. 10th

Peer evaluation groups (You must have a draft of your paper ready): Oct. 28th

Rough draft of the paper is due: Nov. 21st

Final draft of the paper is due: Dec. 14th

Each one of these due dates will earn you 2 points toward your total score of 60 points. The paper will consist of 52 points.
